TROPARION Tone 5: Let us, O faithful, praise and worship the Word, / co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, / born for our salvation of the Virgin; / for He willed to be lifted upon the cross in the flesh, / to endure death, / and to raise the dead // by His glorious Resurrection.

Tone 8: O Ever-virgin Theotokos, protection of mankind: / thou hast given to thy city a mighty legacy, the robe and cincture of thy most honored body, / which have remained incorrupt through thy seedless birthgiving. / For in thee are nature and time renewed. // Wherefore, we beseech thee to grant peace to thy city and great mercy to our souls.

KONTAKION Tone 5: Thou didst descend into Hell, O my Savior, / shattering its gates as Almighty; / as Creator resurrecting the dead, / and destroying the sting of death. / thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of man, // and we cry to Thee, O Lord save us.

Glory... Both now... Tone 4: Today thy temple doth celebrate / the deposition of thy precious cincture, O all-hymned one, / and it earnestly crieth out to thee: / Rejoice, O Virgin, // thou boast of Christians!
