Hymns for the Day

In confirming the common Resurrection, O Christ God, / Thou didst raise up Lazarus from the dead before Thy passion. / Wherefore, we also, like the children bearing the symbols of victory, / cry to Thee, the Vanquisher of death: / Hosanna in the highest; // blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Glory... Tone 4: As by baptism we were buried with Thee, O Christ our God, / so by Thy Resurrection we were deemed worthy of immortal life; / and praising Thee, we cry: / Hosanna in the highest; // blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Both now... Tone 6: Being borne upon a throne in heaven, and upon a colt on the earth, / O Christ God, Thou didst accept the praise of the angels / and the laudation of the children as they cry to Thee: // Blessed is He that cometh to recall Adam.
