TROPARION Tone 3 Let the heavens rejoice; / let the earth be glad; / for the Lord hath shown strength with His arm. / He hath trampled down death by death; / He hath become the first-born of the dead. / He hath delivered us from the depths of Hell / and hath granted the world // great mercy.

Troparion of St Elizabeth: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

KONTAKION Tone 3 On this day Thou didst rise from the tomb, O Merciful One, / leading us from the gates of death. / On this day Adam exulteth as Eve rejoiceth; / with the the Prophets and Patriarchs / they unceasingly praise the divine majesty of Thy power.
