## Hymns for the Day

**TROPARION Tone 7:** By the Cross Thou didst destroy death; / to the thief Thou didst open Paradise, / for the Myrrh-bearers Thou didst change weeping into joy, / and Thou didst command Thy Disciples, O Christ-God, / to proclaim that Thou art risen, // granting the world great mercy.

**Troparion of the Temple:** Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

**Tone II:** Called through divine providence to the hierarchal ministry by the holy Patriarch Tikhon, / thou wast revealed to the flock of Christ / as an ever-vigilant guardian and fearless defender, O hieromartyr Peter. / Cruel imprisonment and distant banishment, sufferings and death / didst thou endure at the hands of those who fought against God, / and having received the crown of martyrdom, in heaven thou dost now rejoice. / Entreat our merciful God, that He preserve our Church from disorders, / that He grant oneness of mind and peace to His people, // and that He save our souls.

**KONTAKION Tone 7:** The dominion of death can no longer hold men captive; / for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers. / Hell is bound; the Prophets rejoice and cry: / The Savior hath come to those in faith. // Enter ye faithful, into the Resurrection.

**Kontakion of the Temple:** Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

**Glory... Tone I:** True to thy sacred oath, thou didst accept death after many torments, / O holy hierarch Peter; / wherefore, thou art gone up in triumph into heaven, / where thy prayers are unceasing for those who honor thy martyrdom. / Glory to Him Who gave thee the strength to prevail! / Glory to Him Who hath accepted thy willing sacrifice! // Glory to Him, O saint, in Whose joy thou ever abidest!

**Both now... Tone 6:** O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
