## Hymns for the Day

**Tone 4:** Supreme Commanders of the heavenly hosts, / we unworthy ones implore you / that by your supplications ye will encircle us / with the shelter of the wings of your immaterial glory, / and guard us who fall down before you and fervently cry: / Deliver us from dangers // since ye are the Marshals of the Hosts on high.
