### TROPARION of the Resurrection.

#### Tone 3:

Let the heavens rejoice; / let the earth be glad; / for the Lord hath shown strength with His arm. / He hath trampled down death by death; / He hath become the First-born of the dead. / He hath delivered us from the depths of Hell // and hath granted the world great mercy.

#### Glory... Tone 3:

As of old Thou didst raise the paralytic, O Lord, / by Thy Divine presence, / raise my soul which is paralyzed grievously / by all manner of sins and unseemly deeds, / that being saved I may cry out: // O compassionate Christ, glory to Thy power.

#### Both now... Tone 8:

Thou didst descend into the tomb, O Immortal, / Thou didst destroy the power of death. / In victory didst Thou arise, O Christ God, / proclaiming "Rejoice!" to the myrrh-bearing women; / granting peace to Thine apostles, // and bestowing resurrection on the fallen.
