Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 5: Let us, O faithful, praise and worship the Word, / co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, / born for our salvation of the Virgin; / for He willed to be lifted upon the cross in the flesh, / to endure death, / and to raise the dead // by His glorious Resurrection.

Troparion of the Temple: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

Tone 8: Having lived well in piety, O blessed Peter, / thou wast like a most precious offshoot of the root of piety; / and thus having pleased God in peace with thy spouse, the all-wise Febronia, / ye were vouchsafed the life of the holy monastics. / With them pray ye to the Lord, that He preserve your homeland unharmed, // that we may honor you unceasingly.

KONTAKION Tone 5: Thou didst descend into Hell, O my Savior, / shattering its gates as Almighty; / as Creator resurrecting the dead, / and destroying the sting of death. / thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of man, // and we cry to Thee, O Lord save us.

Kontakion of the Temple: Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

Glory... Tone 8: Pondering the transitory glory and governance of this world, / for this thou didst live piously in peace with the all-wise Febronia thy spouse, / O Peter, pleasing God with almsgiving and prayers. / Wherefore, lying inseparably in the tomb even after death, ye invisibly impart healing. // Pray ye now unto Christ, that He preserve your city and the people who glorify you.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
