## *Hymns of the Week*

**TROPARION Tone 6:** The Angelic Powers were at Thy tomb; / the guards became as dead men; / Mary stood by Thy grave / seeking Thine most-pure Body. / Thou didst capture Hell not being tempted by it. / Thou didst come to the Virgin granting life. / O Lord Who didst rise from the dead, // glory to Thee.

**Troparion of the Temple:** Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering *and* death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara // Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

**Tone 4:** In their sufferings O Lord, / Thy martyrs received imperishable crowns from Thee, our God; / for, possessed of Thy might, / they cast down the tormentors and set at naught the feeble audacity of the demons. // By their supplications save our souls.

**Tone 8:** With prayerful vigils and outpourings of tears didst thou water thy pillar, / and with sighs from the depths of thy soul thou didst bring forth fruit a hundredfold, / and wast a shepherd, granting the petitions of all. // O Lazarus our father, entreat Christ God, that our souls be saved.

**KONTAKION Tone 6:** When Christ God the Giver of life / raised all the dead from the valley of misery with His mighty hand, / He bestowed resurrection on the human race: // He is the Savior of all the Resurrection, the Life and the God of all.

**Kontakion of the Temple:** Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

**Tone 8:** The radiant choir of martyrs, the luminous company, / descending to us noetically, hath illumined the Church today with wondrous rays, / Wherefore, celebrating their honored memory, we ask of Thee, O our Savior: / through their supplications deliver us from misfortunes, // that we may chant unto Thee: Alleluia.

**Glory... Tone 4:** With gladness the Church of Christ / doth glorify thee in psalms / as a luminary most great. / Wherefore, never cease thou to beseech Christ, // that He grant forgiveness of transgressions unto all.

**Both now... Tone 6:** O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
