Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 7: By the Cross Thou didst destroy death; / to the thief Thou didst open Paradise, / for the Myrrh-bearers Thou didst change weeping into joy, / and Thou didst command Thy Disciples, O Christ-God, / to proclaim that Thou art risen, // granting the world great mercy.

Troparion of the Temple: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

Tone 3: By thy confession of the divine Faith / the Church hath shown thee to be another Paul, / a zealot among her priests; / and Abel crieth out to the Lord with thee, / as doth the righteous blood of Zachariah. / O venerable father, entreat Christ God, // that we be given great mercy.

KONTAKION Tone 7: The dominion of death can no longer hold men captive; / for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers. / Hell is bound, while the Prophets rejoice and cry: / The Savior hath come to those in faith. // Enter ye faithful, into the Resurrection.

Kontakion of the Temple: Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

Glorify... Tone 2: O Paul, who shone forth upon the earth like a star of heavenly splendor, / thou dost now enlighten the universal Church / for which thou didst suffer, / laying down thy life. / And like that of Zachariah and Abel // thy blood crieth out to the Lord.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
