Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 1: When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, / while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body, / Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, / granting life to the world. / the Powers of the Heavens therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of life: / Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ. / Glory to Thy kingdom. // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

Troparion of the Temple: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

Tone 4: O God of our fathers, / deal with us ever according to Thy meekness. / Deprive us not of Thy mercy, / but through the prayers of these Thy saints // direct our life in peace.

KONTAKION Tone 1: As God Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, / raising the world with Thyself. / Human nature praiseth Thee as God, for death hath vanished. / Adam exulteth, O Master. / Eve rejoiceth, for she is freed from bondage and crieth out to Thee: // Thou art the Giver of resurrection to all, O Christ.

Kontakion of the Temple: Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

Tone 3: Assembling today, let us praise in hymns / the never-failing lamp of the noetic Sun; / for thou didst shine forth upon those in the darkness of ignorance, / leading all to the divine heights, / O venerable Paul, adornment of the Thebans, // steadfast foundation of the fathers and the venerable.

Glory... Tone 2: Loving the riches which cannot be stolen, / O all-wise John, / thou didst hate the riches of thy parents; / and, holding the Gospel in thy hands, / thou didst follow after Christ God, // praying unceasingly for us all.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
