Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 4 When the women disciples of the Lord, / learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy resurrection, / they cast away the ancestral curse / and elatedly told the apostles: / death is overthrown; / Christ God is risen, // granting the world great mercy.

Tone 8: Most glorified art Thou, O Christ our God, / Who hast established our holy fathers as luminous stars upon the earth, / and through them didst guide us all to the true Faith. // O Most merciful One, glory be to Thee.

Tone 4: Thou wast like a merchant that seeketh a beautiful pearl, / O glorious sovereign Vladimir, / sitting on the height of the throne of the mother of cities, God-protected Kiev. / Searching and sending to the imperial city to know the Orthodox Faith, / thou didst find Christ, the priceless Pearl, / Who chose thee as a second Paul, / and Who did shake off thy spiritual and physical blindness in the holy font. / Wherefore, we who are thy people celebrate thy falling asleep. / Pray that thy Russian land be saved, / and that Orthodox people // be granted peace and great mercy.

KONTAKION Tone 4 My Savior and Redeemer / as God, rose from the tomb and delivered the earthborn from their chains. / He hath shattered the gates of Hell, / and as Master, // He hath risen on the third day.

Tone 8: The preaching of the apostles and the doctrines of the fathers confirmed the one Faith of the Church. / And wearing the garment of truth, woven from the theology on high, // She rightly divideth and glorifieth the great mystery of piety.

Glory... Tone 8: Like the great Apostle Paul, O most glorious Vladimir, / in old age thou didst leave off all zeal for idols as a childish sophism, / and as a full-grown man thou wast adorned with the royal purple of divine baptism. / And now as thou standest in joy in the presence of Christ the Savior, / pray that thy Russian land be saved, // and that Orthodox people be granted peace and great mercy.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
