Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 1: When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, / while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body, / Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, / granting life to the world. / the Powers of the Heavens therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of life: / Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ. / Glory to Thy kingdom. // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

Tone 1: In giving birth, O Theotokos / Thou didst retain thy virginity / And in falling asleep thou hast not forsaken the world / Thou who art the Mother of Life hast passed over into Life // And by thy prayers, thou dost deliver our souls from death.

Troparion of the Temple: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

Tone 5: Leaving the glory of earthly rank behind, / thou didst inherit the kingdom of heaven; / and with tears of blood as with all-wondrous stones / thou didst adorn crowns of incorruption, / and didst lead to Christ an assembly of athletes. / With the choirs of the angels thou didst find Christ, the never-setting Sun, / in light unwaning, O holy general Andrew. / With those who suffered with thee ever entreat Him, // that He save our souls.

KONTAKION Tone 1: As God Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, / raising the world with Thyself. / Human nature praiseth Thee as God, for death hath vanished. / Adam exulteth, O Master. / Eve rejoiceth, for she is freed from bondage and crieth out to Thee: // Thou art the Giver of resurrection to all, O Christ.

Kontakion of the Temple: Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

Glory... Tone 2: Standing before the Lord in prayer, / like a star preceding the sun, / thou didst gain sight of the desired treasure of the kingdom, / full of ineffable joy; / and for ages without end, O general Andrew, / thou dost unceasingly sing to the immortal King with the angels. // With them pray thou continually for us all.

Both now... Tone 2: Neither the tomb nor death had power over the Theotokos / who is ever watchful in her prayers / and in whose intercession lies unfailling hope. / For as the Mother of Life she has been transported into life // by him who dwelt within her ever virgin womb.
