Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 1: When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, / while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body, / Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, / granting life to the world. / the Powers of the Heavens therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of life: / Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ. / Glory to Thy kingdom. // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

Tone 5: Lo, thy care for thy flock in its sojourn prefigured the supplications / which thou dost ever offer up for the whole world. / Thus do we believe, having come to know thy love, / O holy hierarch and wonderworker John. / Wholly sanctified by God through the ministry of the all-pure Mysteries, / and thyself ever strengthened thereby, / thou didst hasten unto the suffering, O most gladsome healer. / Hasten now also to the aid of us // who honor thee with all our heart.

KONTAKION Tone 1: As God Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, / raising the world with Thyself. / Human nature praiseth Thee as God, for death hath vanished. / Adam exulteth, O Master. / Eve rejoiceth, for she is freed from bondage and crieth out to Thee: // Thou art the Giver of resurrection to all, O Christ.

Glory... Tone 4: Following Christ, the Chief Shepherd, / thou wast shown to be most excellent among hierarchs; / for thou didst save thy sheep from destruction by the godless, / arranging a tranquil refuge for them; / and exercising unceasing care for thy flock, / thou didst heal the infirmities of their souls and bodies./ Entreat Christ God now for us who fall down before thy precious relics, / O father John, // that our souls may be saved in peace.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the Creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
