The First Antiphon

The heavens declare the glory of God, / and the firmament declareth the work of His hands.

Day unto day **poureth** forth speech / and night unto night proclaimeth knowledge.

O Savior, save us.*

The Second Antiphon

The Lord hear thee in the day of affliction; / the name of the God of Jacob defend thee.

Let Him send forth unto thee help from His sanctuary, / and out of Zion let Him help thee.

The Lord grant thee according to thy heart, / and fulfill all thy purposes.

*O Good Comforter, / save us who sing to
Thee: Alleluia.*

The Third Antiphon

O Lord, in Thy strength the king shall be glad, / and in Thy salvation shall he rejoice exceedingly.

The desire of his heart hast Thou granted unto him, / and hast not denied him the requests of his lips.
