## *Hymns of the Week*

**TROPARION Tone 1:** When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, / while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body, / Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, / granting life to the world. / the Powers of the Heavens therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of life: / Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ. / Glory to Thy kingdom. // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

**Tone 8:** As a beautiful fruit of the sowing of Thy salvation, / the land of Russia doth offer to Thee, O Lord, all the Saints that have shone in her. / By their prayers keep the Church and the world in profound peace, // through the Theotokos, O Most-merciful One.

**KONTAKION Tone 1:** As God Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, / raising the world with Thyself. / Human nature praiseth Thee as God, for death hath vanished. / Adam exulteth, O Master. / Eve rejoiceth, for she is freed from bondage and crieth out to Thee: //

Thou art the Giver of resurrection to all, O Christ.

**Glory... Tone 3:** Today the choir of the saints who pleased God in the land of Russia / doth stand before us in Church and invisibly doth pray for us to God. / With them the angels glorify Him, / and all the saints of the Church of Christ keep festival with them; // and they all pray together for us to the Pre-eternal God.

**Both now... Tone 6:** O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
