Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 2: When Thou didst descend to death, O Life Immortal, / Thou didst slay Hell with the splendor of Thy Godhead. / And when from the depths Thou didst raise the dead, / all the Powers of Heaven cried out: // O Giver of life, Christ our God, glory to Thee.

Tone 8: As a beautiful fruit of the sowing of Thy salvation, / the lands of North America offer Thee, O Lord, all the saints that have shone in them. / By their prayers keep the Church and the world in profound peace, // through the Theotokos, O Most-merciful One.

KONTAKION Tone 2. Hell became afraid, O almighty Savior, / seeing the miracle of Thy resurrection from the tomb. / The dead arose; creation with Adam beheld this and rejoiced with Thee, // and the world O my Savior, praiseth Thee forever.

Glory... Tone 3: Today the choir of Saints who were pleasing to God in the lands of North America / now standeth before us in the Church and invisibly prayeth to God for us. / With them the angels glorify Him, / and all the saints of the Church of Christ keep festival with them; // and together they all pray for us to the Preëternal God.

Both now... Tone 6: O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, / O mediation unto the creator unfailing, / disdain not the suppliant voices of sinners, / but be thou quick, O good one, to help us who in faith cry unto thee; / hasten to intercession and speed thou to make supplication, // thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.
