Hymns of the Week

TROPARION Tone 3 Let the heavens rejoice; / let the earth be glad; / for the Lord hath shown strength with His arm. / He hath trampled down death by death; / He hath become the first-born of the dead. / He hath delivered us from the depths of Hell / and hath granted the world // **great mercy.**

Tone 7: Thou wast transfigured on the mountain, O Christ God, / showing Thy glory to Thy disciples as far as they were able to bear it. / At the intercessions of the Theotokos, / Make Thine everlasting light shine forth also upon us sinners. // O Giver of light, glory to Thee.

Troparion of the Temple: Meekness, humility and love dwelt in thy soul / Diligently didst thou minister unto the suffering / O Holy Passion-bearer Princess Elizabeth / With faith didst thou also endure suffering and death for Christ / With the Martyr Barbara / Together with her pray for all them that honor you with love.

Tone 4: In his sufferings O Lord, / Thy martyr Lawrence hath received an imperishable crown from Thee, our God; / for, possessed of Thy might, / he set at nought his tormentors and crushed the feeble audacity of the demons. // By his supplications save Thou our souls.

KONTAKION Tone 3: On this day Thou didst rise from the tomb, O Merciful One, / leading us from the gates of death. / On this day Adam exulteth as Eve rejoiceth; / with the Prophets and Patriarchs // they unceasingly praise the divine majesty of Thy power.

Kontakion of the Temple: Taking up the cross of Christ / Thou hast passed from royal splendor to heavenly glory / Praying for thine enemies / Thou didst find eternal joy together with the martyr, Barbara / O holy martyr, Princess Elizabeth // Wherefore intercede for our souls.

Glory... Tone 2: Kindling thy heart with divine fire, / thou didst utterly reduce the fire of the passions to ashes, / O God-bearing martyr Lawrence, / thou confirmation of athletes; / and in the midst of thy sufferings thou didst cry out with faith: // Nothing can separate me from the love of Christ.

Both now... Tone 7: Tone 7: Thou wast transfigured upon the mountain, / and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, O Christ God, as far as they were able so to do: / that when they saw Thee crucified, / they might know that Thy suffering was voluntary, / and might proclaim unto the world // That Thou art truly the Brightness of the Father.
